Assignment Title: Preparation of Conceptual Solution and Feasibility Study with Preliminary Design for protection of Pozega from the Skrapez river and its tributaries
Reference No. SRB-FERP-QCBS-002-CS-2018

The Republic of Serbia has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Floods Emergency Recovery Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include preparation of technical documentation to define optimum technical solutions for the protection of settlements and traffic infrastructures in Pozega area from the Skrapez river and tributaries high water. Technical documentation shall be developed to increase level of already established protected zones as well as construction of new ones.

The Consultant shall prepare **Conceptual Solution and Feasibility Study with Preliminary Design** and it includes investigation works to collect geodetic, engineering – geological and geotechnical, hydrologic, hydraulic, spatial, legal and infrastructural data. Implementation period is 12 months.

The Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Water Management – Directorate for Water now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

1. General qualifications, managerial and organizational structure
2. Specific experience relevant to the assignment in the last ten years.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers* dated January 2011, revised July 2014 (“Consultant Guidelines”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest. Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub consultancy to enhance their qualifications. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection method set out in the Consultant
