The Republic of Serbia has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Sava and Drina Rivers Corridors Integrated Development Program and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contracts for River training works in Novi Pazar for rivers Raska, Josanica and Trnavica. Bidding process will be governed by the World Bank's Procurement Regulations.
2. The Central Fiduciary Unit of the Ministry of Finance now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for River training works in Novi Pazar for rivers Raska, Josanica and Trnavica. The construction period is:
 - LOT 1: SER-SDIP-W-22-16/1 Raska River: 20 months
 - LOT 2: SER-SDIP-W-22-16/2 Josanica River: 10 months
 - LOT 3: SER-SDIP-W-22-16/3 Trnavica River: 17 monthsNo margin of preference is applicable.
3. Bidders may Bid for one or several contracts, as further defined in the bidding document. Bidders wishing to offer discounts in case they are awarded more than one contract will be allowed to do so, provided those discounts are included in the Letter of Bid.
4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from the Central Fiduciary Unit of the Ministry of Finance and inspect the Bidding document during office hours 09:00 to 15:00 hours at the address given below.
5. The Bidding document in English may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of EURO 30.00 or equivalent in Serbian Dinars (RSD) based on the selling exchange rate published by the National Bank of Serbia on the date of payment.
6. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers-

Procurement in Investment Projects Financing” July 2016, revised November 2017 and August 2018 (“Procurement Regulations”), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.

Bids must be password protected and have hash value.** Late Bids will be rejected. The TECHNICAL PART will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders’ designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend, at the Zoom meeting on October 18, 2023, 12:15 PM. All FINANCIAL PARTS shall remain unopened until the second public Bid opening.
8. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid-Securing Declaration. The Bid-Securing Declaration of a JV shall be in the name of the JV that submits the Bid. If the JV has not been legally constituted into a legally enforceable JV at the time of bidding, the Bid Securing Declaration shall be in the names of all future members as named in the letter of intent referred to in ITB 4.1 and ITB 11.2.

The Bid-Securing Declaration should be submitted for each Lot separately, or in case of bidding for more than one Lot, Bidders have the option of submitting one Bid-Securing Declaration covering all lots for which Bids have been submitted.

9. All Bids must be accompanied by a Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (SEA) and/or Sexual Harassment (SH) Declaration.
10. All Bids must be accompanied by a Labor and Working Condition Declaration.
11. All Bids must be accompanied by an Environmental and Social Declaration.
